

## 2019 Bio Lilit Gampel



Violinist Lilit Gampel enjoys a varied career as soloist, recitalist, chamber musician, orchestral musician, and teacher. She has performed as guest soloist with the New York and Los Angeles Philharmonics, Boston Symphony, and the Concertgebouw, and has collaborated with the legendary Pierre Fournier, Kiril Kondrashin, Joseph Krips, and Zubin Mehta, among others. Her recitals include appearances at the San Francisco Opera House and Chicago's Symphony Hall. Ms. Gampel has performed NY premieres of the Ysaye Sonata for two violins, the Kaikhosru Sorabji piano quintet, and Vernon Duke's string quartet. As concertmaster, she has performed Strauss' *Ein Heldenleben* and with the American Ballet Theatre, and as an orchestra musician, with the Mostly Mozart Festival, New York Chamber Opera Orchestra, and Gotham Chamber Opera Orchestra. Ms. Gampel began studying violin at the age of six. Her mentors include Alice Schoenfeld at University of Southern California and Ivan Galamian at The Juilliard School. Awards include first prize in the Coleman Chamber Music and Young Musicians' Foundation competitions, and the Jacob Javits Fellowship for graduate work in literature.
